Qualification for those working in Dental Nursing

The Level 3 Diploma in Dental Nursing (QCF) provide learners with the knowledge and skills to qualify as a Dental Nurse, supporting patient care and delivery of dental care.

Who is it for?

The Level 3 Diploma in Dental Nursing (QCF) is aimed at individuals who want to work as a dental nurse.

A Dental Nurse provides 'chair-side support' for the dental team, which includes Dentists, Dental Therapists, Hygienists and Technicians.

The role of a dental nurse is regulated by the General Dental Council (GDC). An individual may be able to register with the GDC upon satisfactory completion of a recognised qualification, which includes the Level 3 Diploma in Dental Nursing (QCF).

The Qualification

This qualification will suit you if you are working in an oral health environment and have considerable knowledge and skills in relation to dental equipment, instruments and materials. You are able to work under minimum supervision as a key member of the oral healthcare team.

At this level you'll gain the skills and knowledge you need for chairside work, providing support for a range of dental procedures, including:

- Preparing & maintaining environments, instruments & equipment for clinical dental procedures.
- Providing 'chair-side support' for extraction of teeth & minor oral surgery.
- Dental Radiography
