

Diploma in Green Deal Domestic Advice (QCF) Level 3

Who is it for?

The Level 3 is for people who want to offer 'Green Deal Assessment' and accompanying advice as a qualified and authorised Green Deal Domestic Advisor.

A domestic Green Deal Advisor (GDA) is a qualified individual who undertakes energy calculations using the appropriate Green Deal software on existing dwellings to produce a Green Deal Advice Report (GDAR).



Course Content

The qualification enables the learner to become a Green Deal Advisor and includes the abilities and knowledge to undertake energy inspections, create and lodge EPCs, understand domestic energy assessment and Green Deal policy, issue and lodge Green Deal Assessment Reports, and provide advice to customers based on the Green Deal Assessment Report. The Advisor will have a mixture of technical knowledge, practical competence and 'soft' skills to provide households and businesses with the advice they need to take informed decisions.

The course covers:

- Green Deal legislation & supervisory framework.
- The structure of the Green Deal Industry: Funding, providers, advisors & installers.
- The Code of Conduct & managing conflicts of interest.
- Occupancy Assessment inspection technique & data gathering.
- Green Deal Advice, report data requirement, format & software.
- Understanding the relationship between improvement measures, the building fabric & householder lifestyles.
- Recommending improvement measures appropriate to the household.
- Providing behavioural energy saving advice to householders.
- Explaining Green Deal Plans & consumer rights.
- Portfolio build & assessment.

(The qualification is part of the Governments Green Deal initiative.)

Course Delivery & Assessment

The course will be assessed in a number of different ways to make sure that you have gained the correct understanding in all areas this is via portfolio, tests, observations etc.
