What you'll be doing?

In Youth Work/Informal Education, no two days of work will be the same. There's also an administrative side to youth work. You might help manage volunteers or part-time staff, help apply for grants, keep records of your work, and network with other professionals including social workers, teachers and probation officers.

What skills do you need?

You'll need to be able to come up with creative ways to reach young people, and be able to build relationships with them. You will need to be good at working in a team and working with others. You'll need to be lively, confident and interested in learning something new every-day.

Where will this qualification take you?

On successful completion of the course you will have gained a Diploma in Youth Work Practice (Level 3), and you will also gain a Level 2 Award in Employment Responsibilities and Rights in Health and Level 2 Functional Skills English and Maths.
