Continuous Improvement Techniques

Successful manufacturing is based on three main elements: having the right product in the right place, at the right time, and at the right cost. This is achieved by having continuously improving quality assurance, cost management and delivery systems, often abbreviated to quality, cost and delivery (QCD).

This online training has been developed to provide learners with an understanding of the Kaizen philosophy, in order to encourage the setting and continuous improvement of standards which will improve productivity, safety and effectiveness while reducing waste.

- Understand the principles of Kaizen & Continuous improvement.

- Recognise improvement types.
- Understand the improvement cycle (PDCA).
