# **Problem Solving**

This course looks at a variety of tools to help individuals and teams solve both simple and highly complex problems. Some of the tools are used in healthcare, while others are new to the field.

Every problem is different and may require one or a mixture of tools to solve. The aim of the module is to increase understanding of problem statements, problem solving and to gain an appreciation of error proofing.

Having completed this module, the learner will:

- Know how to create a problem statement.
- Be able to use different problem solving techniques.
- Understand root cause analysis.
- Understand error proofing theory.
- Understand Failure Mode Effects Analysis (FMEA).
