This training course is for anyone who encounters adults at risk of abuse in the community, in a person's own home, in a hospital, in a day care or residential setting. This includes formal and informal carers, volunteers, health and social care professionals.

What you will learn:

- Understanding of issues surrounding the safeguarding of adults at risk.
- Understanding commonly held attitudes towards adults at risk and how these impact on the service provided.
- Understand how values & attitudes can block recognition & effect the decisions professionals make regarding taking action.
- Signs, indicators, definitions & types of abuse including unintentional harm.
- The law: Including key legislation & guidance regarding issues of consent & duty of care.
- What to do if you have any concerns, what your responsibility is, what happens next and the role & responsibility of managers.

This course includes scenarios to help you to think about what you would do in a given situation.
